

APPROVED MLT PROGRAMS

The College of Medical Laboratory Technologists of Alberta (CMLTA) must carry out its activities in a manner that serves and protects the public interest. The CMLTA must ensure an applicant is qualified to practice as a Medical Laboratory Technologist (MLT) and is granted the appropriate permit to practice as specified in sections 3, 4, and 5 of the *Medical Laboratory Technologists Regulation* (the Regulations).

To qualify for registration with the CMLTA, the Regulations require that individuals must complete an education program in medical laboratory science of at least two years' duration which has been approved by Council.
