Renewals submitted in November: \$425
Renewals submitted in December: \$550 (\$425 + \$125 admin fee)
Late renewal submitted after Dec. 31: \$650 (\$425 + \$225 admin fee)

Please allow up to 3 weeks for processing and to receive your 2024 MLT practice permit. Please login to your member profile to see if your permit is available.

Those choosing to renew mid-December, should not expect a 2024 registration and MLT Practice Permit by December 31, 2023.

If you have submitted your renewal and have not yet paid, please login to your member profile to check for outstanding invoices. Oct. 31, 2023 is the last day to take advantage of the \$50 discount. If you pay after this date, you will be charged the full dues of \$425.
